Day 1 Tuesday 21st

After collecting you from your doors this morning we travel to Taupo where you can purchase your lunch and shop before we travel on to the Grand Chateau Tongariro. There could still be some snow around at this time of the year.

Day 2 Wednesday 22nd

After a Chateau breakfast we travel to Waiouru. We visit the War Memorial Museum then on to Taihape, the Gumboot capital of New Zealand. Lunch can be purchased from their many cafés. There is many places to see along HW 1 in to Marton before we transfer you to Wanganui. Staying at the Wanganui Collegiate with dinner in their restaurant this evening.



Day 3 Thursday 23rd

After breakfast this morning we explore the southern Taranaki area with a trip to a very well known garden plus a visit to Tawhiti Museum. After two years of planning and at least a further two years to build the “Traders and Whalers” historical presentation is finished. This attraction sets out to challenge its guests with a stunning creative and hauntingly real environment, based on the Taranaki Coast in the early 1800. An interactive display where you drift in boats through eerie water illuminated by twinkling lanterns and candles. There are life size figurines in lush bush, or rocky coastal environments. Nigel Ogle is a master craftsmen, and this is something not to be missed. We travel back to our accommodation in Wanganui for dinner.



Day 4 Friday 24th

Breakfast this morning and we depart for home stopping in Palmerston North for some shopping before returning you to your doors.

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This garden covers over 3 hectares and in Spring there are daffodils everywhere, a bluebell wood, and rhododendrons and camellias producing glorious displays. In summer the dahlias are a riot of colour and beside the long drive, agapanthus and the most gloriously deep blue hydrangeas you've ever seen complement butter yellow golden elms that line the drive. NZ natives come into their own, with rocks, water features and garden art providing plenty of interest. Sometimes on a sunny day a south-easterly scud will paint rainbows everywhere, even your own personal rainbow that follows you as you walk! Or you may wish to explore find the secret path that is the home of many fairies. After collecting you from you home this morning we travel to the Pohongina Valley via Saddle Road getting a chance to view these massive wind machines before arriving at Songbird Garden. Raewyn will guide you through her special place. We continue on to Ashurst where we will enjoy lunch at the Herb Farm before returning to Hastings and transferring you to your drop off buses.

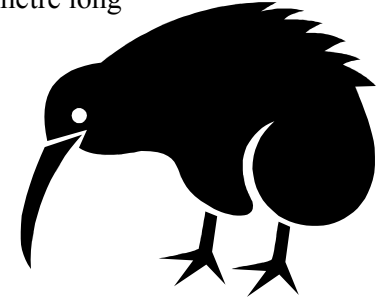
Kiwi Creche - \$75.00

The Pan Pac Kiwi Creche at Lake Opouahi is a truly leading environmental education place in New Zealand. In fact it has won awards for this venture. As a predator-free place for young kiwi, this is a major milestone for Hawke's Bay and for the local charitable organisation, the Environment, Conservation and Outdoor Education Trust (ECOED). ECOED has been working with the local community, the Department of Conservation and the Bank of New Zealand Save the Kiwi Trust to retain and restore a wild population of kiwi in Hawke's Bay.

With less than 500 kiwi left in the wild in Hawke's Bay, North Island brown kiwi are now effectively extinct south of Hawke's Bay and nationally kiwi are declining at six per cent per annum. The Pan Pac Kiwi Crèche is critical to reversing the decline of kiwi in Hawke's Bay.

The Pan Pac Kiwi Crèche is 40 hectares in size and surrounded by a 3.3 kilometre long pest proof fence that excludes anything from mice to cattle and everything in between.

The ECOED 'Save Our Kiwi Hawke's Bay' plan includes locating and monitoring wild kiwi, recovering chicks and raising the chicks to approximately 800 grams in the crèche before returning them to the wild. At 800 grams a wild kiwi is able to defend itself against the most common predator, stoats. After being given a talk by the DOC staff and viewing some kiwi chicks and if your keen, a stroll around the lake, we travel to the Waikare Hotel and enjoy a late hot lunch before returning you to your doors.
